- Resolution 2013-1: Scholarship Fund Criteria & Awarding Rules

We would like to propose the following criteria for the scholarship fund so that the program can move forward and provide aid to our valuable young people supporting the OcFAA community.

1. That the scholarship fund be budgeted from OcFAA fundraisers, with an amount of at least \$500.00, which can be disbursed according to the following guidelines:
  - a. It can be awarded to a youth, 30 years and younger;
  - b. The youth is /has been an active member (active means the youth is not just a registered member, but is/has been also involved in organizing or assisting with the achievement of OCFAA goals and mission);
  - c. The youth has been active in raising funds for OCFAA programs and supports the mission of OCFAA.
  - d. The youth has been active in OCFAA activities and fundraisers for at least two years (not necessarily consecutively).
2. That the award of the scholarship is contingent on its use to further the youth's education, either by enrollment in a community college or in a university. Proof of enrollment is necessary to finalize the disbursement of the award.
3. That the award is a one-time award to one youth applicant. This is to give others a chance to win the scholarship.
4. That the award to a successful applicant be the full amount of \$500.00. For example, if the fund has \$1,000.00, the Board may choose to disburse two \$500.00 awards if there are two successful applicants. If there is only one successful applicant, then the Board may only award one \$500.00 award, and the remaining \$500.00 will be kept in the fund for future applicants.
5. That part of the reason for the above criteria for the scholarship fund is to encourage our youth to be more active in the OcFAA, and to learn to take leadership roles in OcFAA activities.
6. The eligible applicant may be nominated by any member of OcFAA or eligible applicants may apply for the scholarship themselves by writing to the OcFAA board and board advisors.
7. The scholarship is awarded by the majority vote of the Board of Officers based upon the application letter explaining why they deserved to receive the scholarship.
